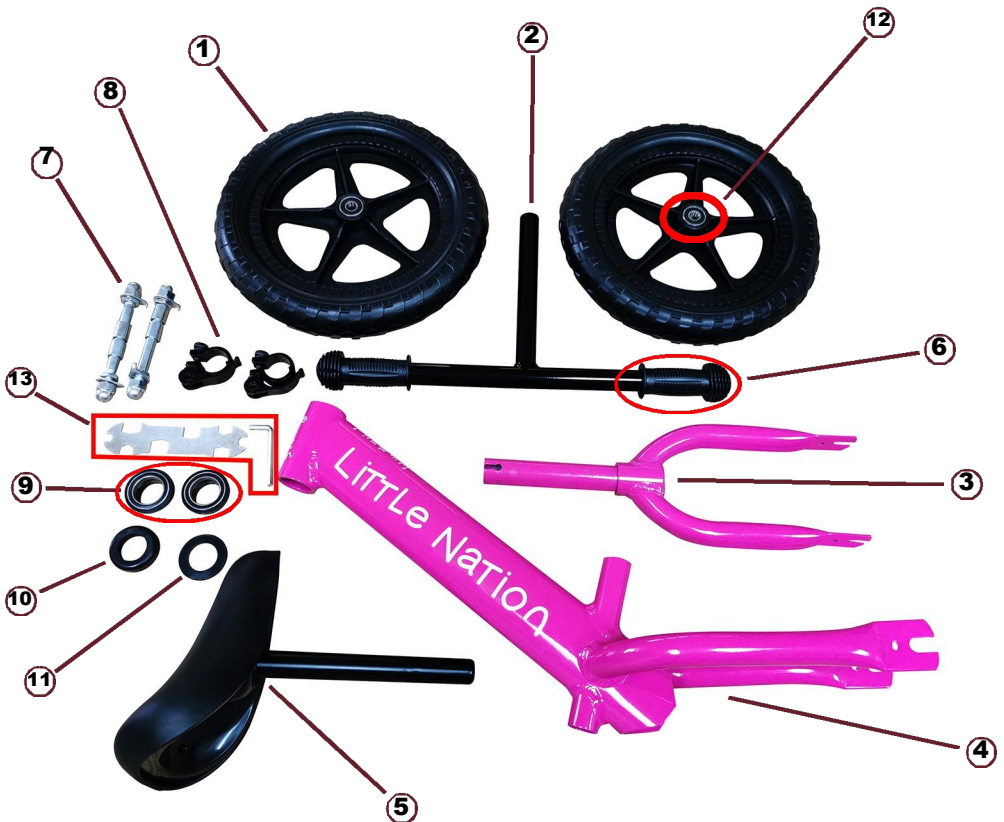

# Balance Bike Assembly Manual

**Assemble the front fork & handle bars**



**The headset consists of 4 parts. A large washer. 2 bearing bushings and a small washer. The small washer goes on the bottom of the head set and at the base of the forks. The larger washer connects at the top of the headset.**



**Push the 2 bearing bushings into the frame tube**



**Place the large washer on top of the top bushing bearing**

**Put the small washer over the fork top and push the fork through the frame**

**Place a black clamp over the fork top and put the handlebars through the fork top. Tighten the clamp**



**Assemble the seat.**



**Put the second black clamp  
on the frame seat pole.  
Keep the clamp at the top  
of the pole.**

**Push the seat post through the frame and tighten the clamp**



**Assemble the wheels**



**Turn the bike upside down**

**Take a wheel and an axle**





**Remove the end nuts, hooked washer and long washer and push the axle through the wheel. If the axle is unable to go through the wheel. There is a washer inside the middle of the 2 wheel bearings that can be moved around by tapping the wheel.**

**Replace the long washer and inside nut and fit through the frame.**



**Replace the hooked washer and put into the frame hole. replace the end nut and tighten.**





**Please now go through and check all nuts, bolts and clamps have been correctly tightened**

## **WARNING**

**TO AVOID SERIOUS INJURY: Continuous adult supervision is required; never use near steps, sloped driveways, motor vehicles, hills, alleys, swimming pool areas, public roads; always wear sturdy shoes and a properly adjusted helmet. Gloves are also a good idea. Never allow more than one rider. Riding is hard work and children should be physically able to control the bike.**

**This is a partially assembled riding toy requiring assembly by an adult according to this manual. The un-assembled bike and shipping box contain small parts that are a CHOKING HAZARD to young children. Please take care to keep these small parts away from young children.**

**Appropriate Age: 1½ to 5 Yrs  
Maximum rider weight: 27 kg / 60 lbs**

## Maintenance

Just like a normal bike, your child's balance bike needs a little maintenance to keep it safe and running smoothly. They are fairly simple tasks however do not begin any tasks if you are unsure in your ability. Incorrect service may void manufacturer's warranty.

- Before each use, ensure all nuts, bolts and clamps are secure.
- Clean rims and check for weaknesses like cracks
- Check frame alignment and check for cracks or damage. Replace any worn components as necessary
- Place a lubricant on the headset bushings for a smoother ride.
- Cleaning mud and dust regularly will protect against rust and keep bike in good condition.
